



Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 3 Autumn 1 - 2025

English

Our focus text for this half term will be *Diary of a Killer Cat* by Anne Fine. We will read the text in class and practice our retrieval and inference skills in Guided Reading sessions. In our grammar lessons we will learn how to use adverbs, adjectives and conjunctions in sentences and fronted adverbials. This text will inspire our writing. We will create narrative pieces focused on the characters in these books bringing together our new learning from the GAPS (grammar, spelling and punctuation) curriculum. We will also be doing Guided Reading activities linked to our History topic- The Stone Age.
