Residential (2-Night) Retreats (Ages 9-14):

These retreats are designed for young people in Year 5 to Year 9, offering a two-night stay at Alton Castle. The programs are crafted to inspire personal growth, teamwork, and spiritual development.

A NEO-GOTHIC MARVEL

The castle itself is a remarkable Grade II listed neo-Gothic building designed by A.W. Pugin and constructed in 1847. It stands within the evocative ruins of a medieval castle dating back to approximately 1176, now designated as a Grade I listed scheduled ancient monument.



What is a Residential Retreat at Alton Castle?

- "Our retreat programmes combine teaching young people more about their faith, spending time in prayer, meditation and reflections, with outdoor adventurous activities. Ride out into the valley on one of our mountain bikes, trek out into the countryside, or scale our climbing wall, all whilst exploring and deepening your faith."
- "Our residential retreats are unique in the way the experience of creation, and times of community prayer, are woven through challenging activities. Retreatants are pushed to trust in each other, to work together, and to conquer challenges as they encounter Christ in each other and in the activities they take part in."

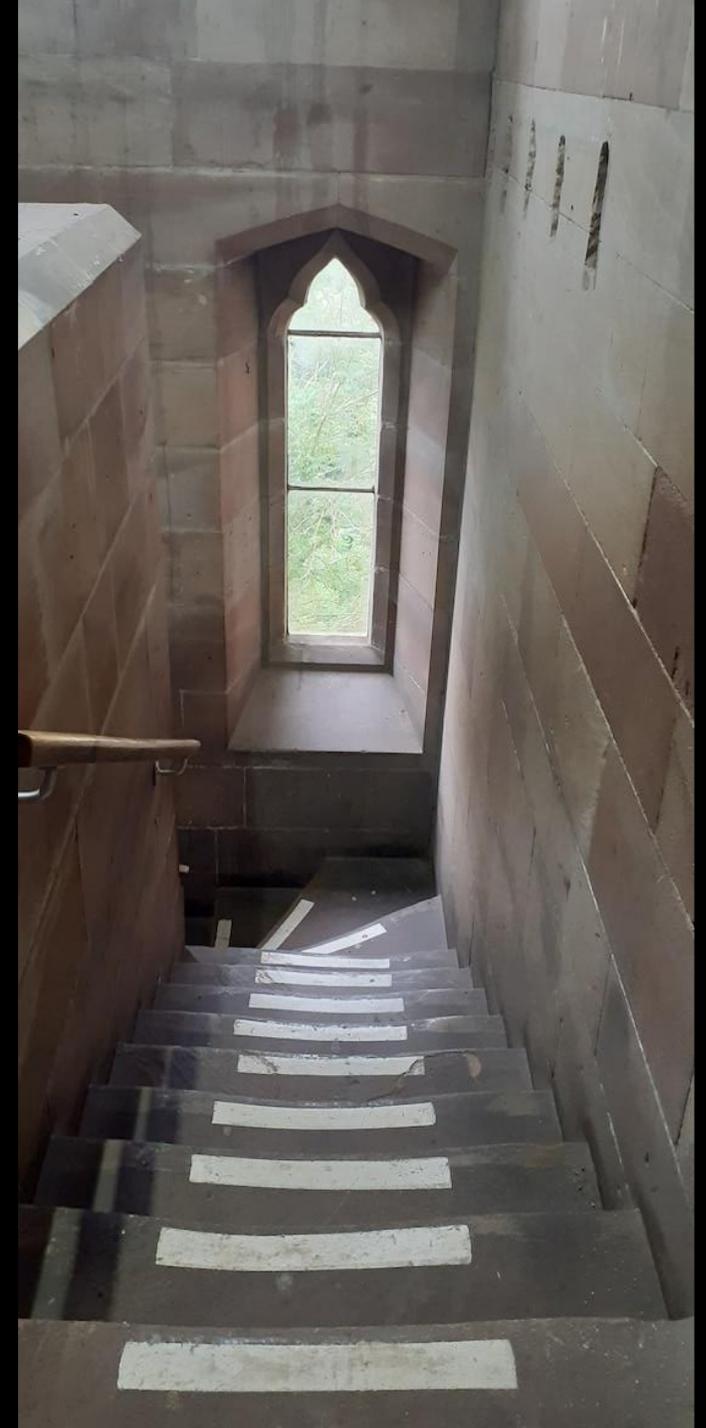
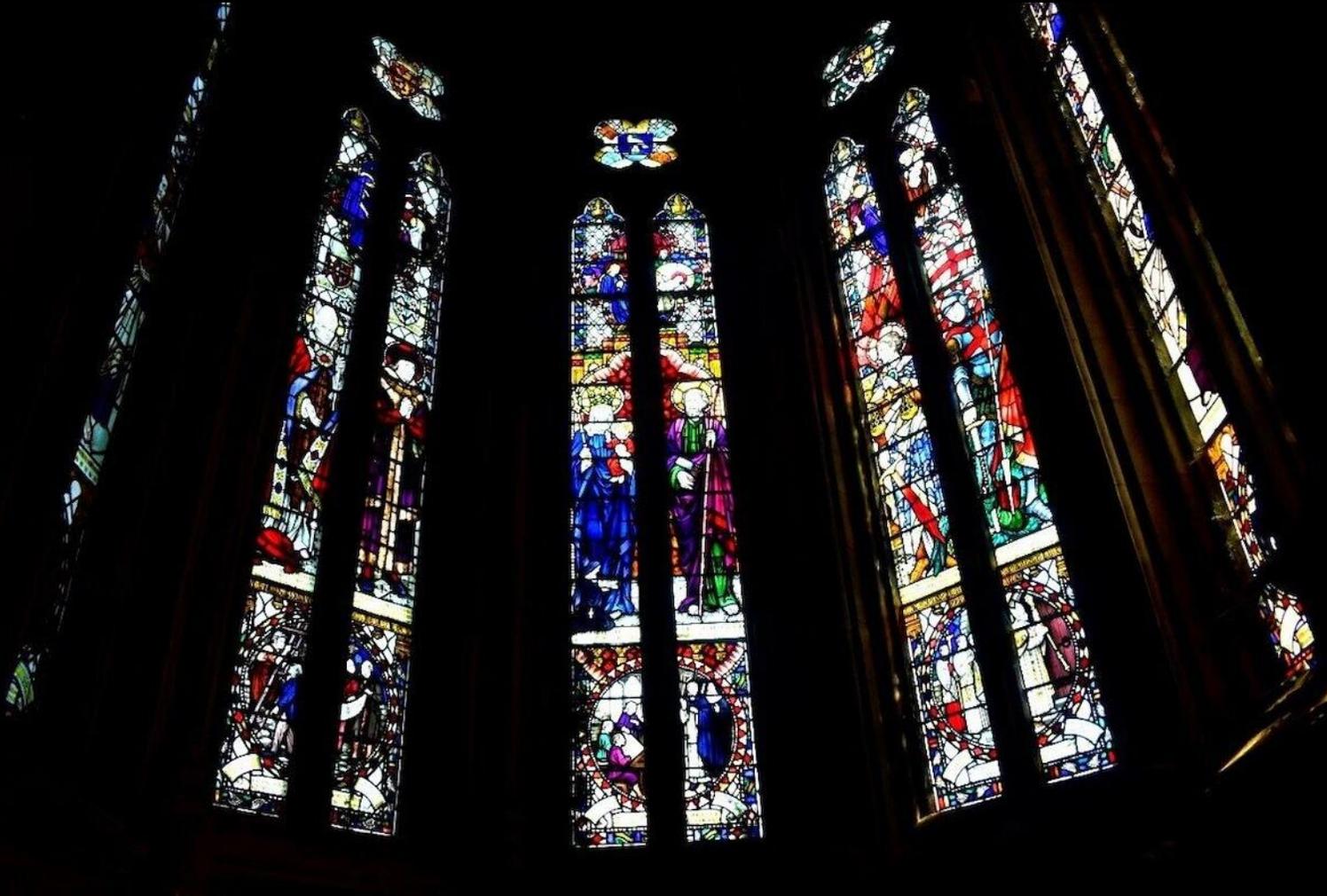

Challenging Activities:

Activities



What does my child need to pack?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Sleeping bag
- Personal toiletries (including toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, etc.)
- Pair of pjamas
- Money for tuck shop (recommended £10)
- Towel
- Sun cream
- Sun hat (summer retreats)/woolly hat, scarf and gloves (winter retreats)
- 4 t-shirts (at least 1 long sleeved top)
- 3 pairs of loose fitting trousers (leggings or joggers)
- 2 warm long-sleeved jumpers
- 1 thick fleece/jacket

- 1 waterproof coat
- Waterproof trouser (if possible)
- 2 pairs of walking socks
- Pair of wellies or walking boots (there are some wellies available to borrow if necessary)
- 5 pairs of underwear
- 1 pair of old trainers (to be worn outside - they will get muddy)
- 1 pair of indoor shoes (not slippers - trainers are ideal)
- Water bottle
- Torch (optional)

PLEASE NOTE:

We advise that personal electronics are not brought on retreat - all electronics are brought at owners' risk. Electronics, such as hairdryers and straighteners, cannot be used on retreat. Each visitor will have to carry their bag to their room - this may involve walking up many flights of stairs so please pack a bag that you can carry.
