

# CURRICULUM IN YEAR 4

Each half term, a parent planner is uploaded to our class page on the website. This shows everything that we will cover for the half term.

Our History and Geography topics link to multiple subjects. These topics are:

The Romans, Boudicca, Europe, the changes of Birmingham during the Victorian period and Rivers.

# CLASS RULES AND REWARDS

Children are rewarded for good behaviour and work with our class behaviour chart, stickers and house points. A child who has worked hard the day before will be selected to look after our class monkey.

Each half-term, the children also collect class points to receive a whole-class reward. This half-term, the children are working towards a movie afternoon with popcorn!



# CLASSWORK

Children will work mostly in their books as well as completing a range of practical activities. Please see Bluesky!

Weekly tests will happen for times tables/ learn it's and spellings.

We will also have three assessment weeks throughout the year where we will assess each child's progress and put into place any interventions to support them.

# HOMework

**Spellings** – Each week, spellings will be uploaded to Google Classroom. Please help your child to learn these. Children will be tested weekly on their spellings.

**Times tables** – Children should login to TTRS to practise their multiplication. Logins have been glued into their homework books. Little and often is great practise!

**Learn Its** – Learn Its booklets consist of 5 sheets. Depending on what step your child is on, they will either have 30, 60 or 90 seconds to complete each sheet. Children will be tested on these each week and if they can complete the sheet in the allotted time then they will move to the next step.

**Reading journals** – Please encourage your child to read at home both with an adult and independently if they can. Children should complete 1 activity in their reading journal per week. Please focus on quality rather than quantity.

**Reading at home** – Please read with your child on a regular basis and record their reading in their reading diary. This will also be updated when they have read in school.

**Homework will be set via Google Classroom on a Friday. This will consist of spellings, a times table activity and a reading journal activity. Please hand in homework via Google Classroom on a Wednesday so it can be marked. Reading journals will need to be handed into school. .**

# RE

**Attendance at Family Mass is very much appreciated.**

**Lessons** – RE is taught **twice a week** in class.

**Class prayers** – Prayers are said throughout the day in class.

**Prayer bag** – This will be sent home with one child each Friday and returned the following Friday. Inside are resources to support prayer at home.

**Prayer services** – These will happen in class each week on a Thursday. They will be led by the children and I will support them.

**Values and virtues** – In school, we like to embody the Catholic School Pupil Profile 'Values and Virtues'. They change each half term and we are always striving to use them in our everyday life.

# PE

PE will be on **Monday** and **Wednesday** each week.

Please ensure your child comes to school wearing their PE kit.

# MULTIPLICATION CHECK

This year, the children will complete a times tables test in June.

This will check their knowledge of times tables up to  $12 \times 12$ . Practicing times tables with your children at home will be extremely valuable in the lead up to the check.

The test will be administered in school and will be completed on an electronic device.

There will be a Zoom parent meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> January 2026 at 6pm to explain the check in more detail. The test is very similar to 'Sound Check' on Times Tables Rock Stars.


