- ▶ Reading journals - need to be of a high standard and good quality
- ▶ Reading at home - please hear your children read and read to them regularly - this is vitally important!
- ▶ Other homework will be project homework every half term. All expectations and homework can be found on the Year 6 class pages and homework will also be on google classroom.
